SNG-ANS 930, Kraay-Hirmer 388. **EXTREMELY RARE.** Dark areas on edge over deposits and some corrosion

- 20 **KINGS OF THRACE. Lysimachos, 323-281 BC.** GOLD Stater, ca. 297-281 BC. Uncertain Macedonian mint. 8.53 gm. Head of deified Alexander r. wearing horn of Ammon / Athena Nikephoros seated l., holding Nike, Φ before, bull butting l. in ex. Müller 358

- 22 **DYNASTS OF THRACE. Koson. Mid-First Century BC.** GOLD Stater. 8.7 gm. Roman consul walking l. accompanied by two lictors, monogram before / Eagle standing l. on scepter, holding wreath. RPC 1701, BMC 2 EF 600.
- 23 **THRACIAN CHERSONESOS. Lysimachia. Third Century BC.** AE 18. Head of city-goddess r. / Lion seated r., AV monogram upper left. BMC 9-10var. *Olive sea-green.* Choice for type Choice VF 100.
- 24 **EUBOEAN LEAGUE. Ca. 357-338 BC.** Drachm. 3.68 gm. Head of the nymph Euboeia l. / Filleted head of bull r., small facing head of Silenos at right. SNG-Cop 483. *Nice broad flan.* Choice EF 2,000.

- 25 **ATHENS. After 449 BC.** Tetradrachm. 17.17 gm. Helmeted head of Athena r. / Owl facing, olive sprig and crescent behind; A ϵ E. Cf. Dewing 1625. *Well-centered, full profile. Some graininess* **Choice VF** **600.**
- 26 **AIGINA. Ca. 525-500 BC.** Stater. 11.53 gm. "T-back" sea-turtle / Mill-sail, deep incuse of four segments. SNG Delepierre 1509, Dewing 1657. *Well-centered. Somewhat granular surfaces. Toned* **VF** **350.**
- 27 **THESSALY. Skotussa. Ca. 480-450 BC.** Drachm. 5.94 gm. Forepart of horse l. / Wheat kernel (or hellebore bud) and ΣΚΟ in deep incuse square. BMC 2, SNG-Cop 250. **RARE.** *Light gray* **Good VF** **400.**

- 28 **CRETE. Knossos. Ca. 330-300 BC.** Stater. 10.79 gm. Demeter head r., bull head c/m in right field / Minotaur's labyrinth – maeander pattern with five pellets in center. Svor.71, 46; Le Rider vii, 4-8; SNG-Lockett 2536 (same dies); BMC 4var. *Numerous pinscratches obv and rev. Toned* **VF** **1,500.**

- 29 **KINGS OF THE BOSPOROS. Asander, 46-17 BC.** GOLD Stater, regnal year 10 (36 BC). 8.16 gm. Diademed head of Asander r. / Nike standing l. on prow, holding wreath in outstretched hand, year 'I' before her; ΒΑΣΙΛΕΩΣ ΑΣΑΝΔΡΟΥ. Anohin *Bosporos* 232. **RARE.** *Light old test scratch obverse field. Some deposits in fields* **VF** **5,000.**
Pharnakes II's son-in-law, Asander took the Bosporan throne after slaying the Roman nominee. He was confirmed as king by Marc Antony and, later, Augustus.

- 30 **MYSIA. Kyzikos. Ca. 478-413 BC.** Electrum Stater. 16.1 gm. Boar standing l. on tunny / Quadripartite incuse square. Von Fritze 90, pl.III, 9. *Diagonally oblong flan; horizontal spade as viewed from reverse. Pinscratches in left field and on the boar's head. Obverse slightly off center losing hindquarters of the boar* **VF** **3,000.**

- 31 **Kyzikos. Ca. 478-413 BC.** Electrum Stater. 16.03 gm. Nude Herakles kneeling l., a club over his shoulder, holding a rhyton, tunny upwards behind / Quadripartite incuse square with high-relief borders. Von Fritze 15, 209. **VERY RARE. A few edge splits** **Choice VF** **10,000.**



- 32 **Kyzikos. Ca. 478-413 BC.** Electrum Stater. 16.01 gm. Herakles (clean-shaven) crouching r. wrestling the Nemean lion, whose head he holds in a neck hold, tunny below / Quadripartite incuse square. Von Fritze 161, pl. V, 9; Boston MFA 1494. **RARE** **VF** **7,500.**

Herakles first labor was to slay the Nemean lion, an offspring of Typhon and Echidna.



- 33 **Kyzikos. Ca. 478-413 BC.** Electrum Stater. 16.01 gm. Herakles as a child seated facing, head r., holding a tunny by its tail / Quadripartite incuse square. Von Fritze pl.5, 17; Greenwell pl.IV, 12. **VERY RARE. Horizontally oblong** **VF** **7,500.**



- 34 **Kyzikos. Ca. 460-400 BC.** Electrum 1/6 Stater. 2.7 gm. Bust of Attis r. / Quadripartite granulated incuse square. Cf. Brett *Boston Museum* 1523. *Obverse scuffed* **VF** **900.**

- 35 **Kyzikos. 390-330 BC.** Tetradrachm. 14.95 gm. Head of Kore-Soteira l., wreathed with corn and veiled; ΣΩΣΤΕΙΡΑ / Head of roaring lion l., tunny below, small oinochoe in right field; K-Y-HI (the H sidewise). Cf. SNG-Cop 53. *Toned over a few old faint obv. scratches. Nice style* **Near EF** **1,000.**
