- 41 **LYCIAN LEAGUE. Late First Century BC.** Hemidrachm. 1.87 gm. Wreathed head of Apollo r., hair in hanging coils / Lyre, ethnic and tripod in incuse square. Troxell 110. *Fine style and a pleasing strike. Lightly toned* **Good VF** 200.
- 42 **PISIDIA. Adada. First Century BC.** AE14. Filleted bull's head facing, star between horns / Triskeles; ΑΔ(A). *Olive-green over minor roughness* **About EF** 250.

- 43 **SELEUKID KINGS OF SYRIA. Antiochus III, 223-187 BC.** Tetradrachm. *Uncertain mint.* 16.94 gm. Diademed head r. / Apollo seated l. on omphalos holding an arrow and bow. Houghton--, Lorber--. *Perhaps unpublished. Handsome portrait of fine style. Lightly toned over light surface marks. Apollo's head flatly struck* **Choice VF** 750.
- 44 **Antiochos III.** Drachm, 205-200 BC. Nisibis. 3.83 gm. Diademed head r. / Elephant walking r. Newell, *ESM* 631; SNG-Spaer 693. *Toned over minor porosity* **Good VF** 350.

- 45 **PHOENICIA. Sidon. Ba'Ishallim II, ca. 386-372 BC.** Trishekel. 27.61 gm. Galley sailing l. on zigzag waves, Phoenician B above / King of Persia in chariot l. with driver, Egyptian attendant behind. BMC 17, cf. J.W. Betlyon, "A New Chronology for the Pre-Alexandrine Coinage of Sidon," *ANSMN* 21, 16. *Edge split. Crude toned* **VF** 900.

- 46 **ALEXANDRINE EMPIRE OF BABYLON. Ca. 328-311 BC.** Double Shekel (Tetradrachm). 16.5 gm. Baal seated l. hldg scepter within beaded circle / Lion walking l., no symbols, within beaded circle. BMC *Arabia* 12, SNG-Cop 261. *Some scratches and nicks in fields* **VF** 300.
- 47 **BABYLON. Ca. 328-311 BC.** Double Shekel (Tetradrachm). 16.36 gm. Types similar to last, but Γ above lion. BMC *Arabia* 36, SNG-Delepiepierre 3005, Babelon 287. *Baal's and lion's head flatly struck* **VF** 250.
- 48 **BABYLON. Under the Seleukids. Seleukos I, second satrapy, 312-280 BC.** Double Shekel, (Tetradrachm), ca. 311-305 BC. 15.72 gm. Baal seated l. holding scepter within beaded circle / Lion walking l. on exergual line, anchor above, within beaded circle. Newell *ESM* 263, Houghton 88.2a. *Well-struck for type. RARE this nice* **Good VF** 500.
- 49 **BABYLON. Seleukos I.** Double Shekel, ca. 311-305 BC. 15.02 gm. Types similar to last, but Γ below reverse anchor and large monogram 'A' in ex. Houghton 88.8var. *Some minor graininess. Well-struck for type. RARE this nice* **Good VF** 500.

- 50 **BABYLON. Seleukos I.** Double Shekel (Tetradrachm), ca. 311-305 BC. 16.17 gm. Types similar to above. Rv. Anchor above lion, monogram ΠΗΥ in ex. Newell *ESM* 270, Houghton 88.2b. Top of lion's head flatly struck, but overall decent strike **VF** 300.
- 51 **BABYLON. Seleukos I.** Double Shekel (Tetradrachm), ca. 311-305 BC. 14.94 gm. Types similar to last. Rv. Γ below anchor, monogram `yy' within rectangle and leaf on stem to right in ex. Newell *ESM* 274var., Houghton 88.7c.var. *Baal's and lion's head flatly struck. Thin reverse diebreak* **VF** 250.

- 52 **PARTHIAN HEGEMONY. Vardanes I, 40-45 AD.** Tetradrachm, 43/4 AD. *Seleukeia on the Tigris*. 13.8 gm. Bust l., wearing looped diadem / King enthroned r., Tyche standing l. before him presenting a palm and holding a cornucopiae, date ENT above. Sell.64. *Lightly toned over a few old scratches in obv. field* **VF** 100.
- 53 **Pakoros II, 78-105 AD.** Billon Tetradrachm. *Seleukeia on the Tigris*. 8.59 gm. Beardless, diademed bust l. Γ behind / Pakoros enthroned l. receiving diadem from Tyche who stands before him, uncertain date -T above. Cf. Sell.73. *Flan crack. Grainy* **VF** 125.
- 54 **Pakoros II.** Billon Tetradrachm, 92/3 AD, month of February. *Seleukeia on the Tigris*. 12.43 gm. Bust l. wearing tiara adorned with `hooks,' Δ behind / Pakoros enthroned l. receiving diadem from Tyche. Sell.77. *Small test cut on reverse. Granular* **About VF** 125.

- 55 **Vologases III, 105-147.** Billon Tetradrachm, 121/2 AD, month of September. *Seleukeia on the Tigris*. 13.33 gm. Bust l. wearing tiara with hooks, Γ behind / King enthroned l. receiving diadem from Tyche who stands before him, date ΓΛΥ above, month -BEPETEIOY below. Sell.79. *Small diecracks, flan flaw on rev. king's head. Slightly grainy. Toned* **Good VF** 200.
- 56 **Vologases III.** Billon Tetradrachm, 123/4 AD. *Seleukeia on the Tigris*. 13.92 gm. Types similar to above, but B behind bust and date ΕΛΥ above. Sell.79. *King's head on rev. flatly struck. Otherwise* **Good VF** 200.
- 57 **Vologases IV, 147-191.** Billon Tetradrachm, 173/4 AD. *Seleukeia on the Tigris*. 10.78 gm. Diademed bust l., earring visible, B behind / King seated l. receiving diadem from Tyche who stands before him, date ΕΦΥ above. Sell.84. *Somewhat grainy. Small obv. deposit. Typical crude reverse* **VF** 100.



- 58 **KINGS OF PERSIS. Uncertain King, ca. 150-100 BC.** Drachm. 4.04 gm. Head r. wearing satrapal cap with eagle and crescent / Fire altar with bust of Ahura-Mazda flanked by king and eagle standard. Alram 551. *Dark toning over some deposits* **Good VF** **250.**
- 59 **Darios (Darev) II. Ca, First Century BC.** Drachm. 3.87 gm. Bearded bust l. wearing a tiara adorned with a crescent / King standing l. worshipping at altar. Alram 564var, De Morgan p.406, 30var. *Lightly toned* **Good VF** **150.**
- 60 **Pakor I, ca. 50-1 BC.** Drachm. 3.88 gm. Diademed bust l. / Diademed bust l. Alram 589. *Lightly toned* **EF** **175.**
- 61 **Pakor I.** Drachm. 2.0 gm. Diademed bust l. / Triskeles. **RARE** **EF** **200.**



- 62 **INDO-GREEK KINGS OF BAKTRIA. Diodotos I, the name of Antiochos II of Syria. Ca. 255-235 BC.** GOLD Stater. Attic standard. 8.3 gm. *Mint 'A'* (near Ai Khanoum). Diademed head of Diodotos I r. / Zeus advancing l., holding a thunderbolt, an aegis draped over his extended left arm, eagle before him, N in left field; ΒΑΣΙΛΕΩΣ ΑΝΤΙΟΧΟΥ. Cf. MIG 63, Holt Series A Group 7 (Tetradrachm) for type; SC 629. *Scratches behind the head. Large attractive portrait on a broad flan (for series). No test cuts and Rare thus* **EF** **5,000.**



- 63 **BAKTRIA. Diodotos II, ca. 235-230/225 BC.** GOLD Stater. *Mint 'A'* (near Ai Khanoum). 8.32 gm. Diademed head of Diodotos I r. / Zeus advancing l., holding a thunderbolt, an aegis draped over his extended left arm, eagle before him, wreath in left field; ΒΑΣΙΛΕΩΣ ΔΙ ΟΔΟΤΟΥ. Bop--, MIG--. **VERY RARE.** *Light obv. deposits, scrape on edge and back of head and some obv. pinscratches. Superb style* **EF and About as Struck** **7,500.**



- 64 **BAKTRIA. Eukratides I, ca. 171-145 BC.** Drachm. 4.07 gm. Diademed and draped bust r. / The Dioskouroi riding r., monogram below. MACW 1406 **Good VF** **275.**
