Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust r.; M AVR CARINVS NOB CAES / The three Monetae standing facing, their heads left (representing the three mint branches – aes, argentums and aurum [bronze, silver and gold]). Each holds scales in her right hand and a cornucopiae in the left, a small pile of coins is at their feet; MO-NETA AV-GG. 8; Pink, “Die Medaillonprägung unter Carus und Seinen Söhnen,” *ANS Centennial Publication*, p.556, 6a; Cohen 58. **VERY RARE.** *Rich olive toffee-brown.
