- 433 **AUSTRIA. Archduke Leopold, 1619-1632.** Taler, 1632. *Hall.* Crowned, armored half-figure r. hldg scepter and sword, date vertically before / Crowned Arms in Order Chain; legend ends TIROLI. KM 804.3. *Tooled. Once lacquered and toned* **VF** **150.**
- 434 **HRE Ferdinand III, 1637-1658.** GOLD Ducat, 1644. *Breslau, p.m.* goose in circle (mint official *Georg Reichart*). 4.97 gm aggregate weight. Crowned bust r. wearing square brocade collar / Crowned Imperial eagle. KM 70. Set in late 17th-18th Century twisted furl mount with loop. **About EF** **500.**
- 435 **Leopold, 1657-1705.** 15 Kreuzer, 1663 CA. *Vienna.* Laureate bust r. in double circle / Crowned Imperial eagle. *Some weakness on obverse from beveled strike* **EF** **60.**

- 436 **SALZBURG. Paris v. Lodron, 1619-1653.** Taler, 1623. Madonna and Child above tasseled oval Arms / St. Rupert stdg above Arms. Dav.3504 **EF to About UNC** **250.**
- 437 Taler, 1624. Types as above. *Scrape and mount repair at 12:00. Toned* **VF** **100.**
- 438 **Maximilian Gandolf, Graf v. Kuenberg, 1668-1687.** 1/2 Taler, 1668. Hat over tasseled Arms / Sts. Rupert and Virgil seated facing each other. KM 189. *Whitish silver* **Good VF** **150.**
- 439 15 Kreuzer, 1685. St. Rupert seated facing above value / Hatted and tasseled Arms. KM 230. *Toned* **About UNC** **150.**

- 440 **Johann Ernst v. Thun und Hohenstein, 1687-1709.** ¼ Taler, 1695. Madonna and Child above tasseled oval Arms / St. Rupert stg facing above Arms. KM 282. *Some mint frost* **UNC** **250.**
- 441 **WALLENSTEIN. Albrecht v. Wallenstein as Duke of Friedland and Sagan.** 3 Kreuzer, 1629. Bust ¾ r. wearing half-moon collar/Eagle with large Arms on breast. F&S 2052, KM 32. *Scarce.* **VF** **75.**



- 442 **AUSTRIAN NETHERLANDS. Joseph II, 1780-1790.** Taler, 1785. Peruked head r. / St. Andrew's Cross with crowns in three angles and golden Fleece in the fourth. Dav 1284. *Some weakness at centers* **EF** **125.**



- 443 **CRETE. Prince George, 1898-1906.** 50 Lepta, 1901. Bare head r. / Crowned Arms. KM 6. *Lightly toned* **UNC** **700.**
- 444 **DENMARK. Christian IV, 1588-1648.** Mark, 1614. Armored half-figure r., crown breaking braided circle / Value above Arms on long cross. Hede 99a, KM 52. *With typical weakness. Original mint lustre* **Choice EF to About UNC** **250.**

- 445 **AUGSBURG. Freistadt.** GOLD Ducat, 1645. 3.46 gm. Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust of HRE Ferdinand III r. / Oval City-Arms. KM 83. *Minor flan defect obverse field* **EF** **1,000.**
