- 442** **AUSTRIAN NETHERLANDS. Joseph II, 1780-1790.** Taler, 1785. Peruked head r. / St. Andrew's Cross with crowns in three angles and golden Fleece in the fourth. Dav 1284. *Some weakness at centers* **EF** **125.**



- 443** **CRETE. Prince George, 1898-1906.** 50 Lepta, 1901. Bare head r. / Crowned Arms. KM 6. *Lightly toned* **UNC** **700.**
- 444** **DENMARK. Christian IV, 1588-1648.** Mark, 1614. Armored half-figure r., crown breaking braided circle / Value above Arms on long cross. Hede 99a, KM 52. *With typical weakness. Original mint lustre* **Choice EF to About UNC** **250.**

- 447 BRANDENBURG-BAYREUTH. Christian, 1603-1655.** GOLD Ducat, 1642. 3.4 gm. Draped and cuirassed bust r. wearing a ruff / Oval Arms. KM 57. *Edge defect at 5:30 (lamination w/ gutter). A few light scratches behind bust* **About EF** **600.**
