- 471 GREAT BRITAIN. George I, 1714-1727. GOLD. Guinea, 1723. Fifth laureate head r. / Crowned cruciform Arms, crossed scepters with garter at center. S.3633. Somewhat softly struck **Almost EF** 2,000.
- 472 George II, 1727-1760. GOLD. 2 Guineas, 1738. Laureate head l. / Crowned Arms. S.3667A. Some faint pinscratches behind head **About UNC** 3,500.
- 473 Victoria, 1837-1901. GOLD. 5 Pounds, 1887. Crowned Jubilee bust l. / St. George. S.3864, KM 769. Some stacking marks **UNC** 1,500.
- 474 George VI, 1936-1952. GOLD. Sovereign, 1937. Bare head l. / St. George. S.4076, KM 859. 5,500 pieces struck **Brilliant PROOF** 1,500.
