



- 485 HUNGARY. Ferdinand III, 1637-1657. Taler, 1655 KB. Kremnitz. Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust r. wearing square collar / Crowned Imperial eagle. Dav 3198. *Very appealing medium gray patina.* **EF** 350.
- 486 Taler, 1656 KB. Types as above. *Light medium-gray. Softness of strike in peripheries. Eye appeal as nice as the lot above* **EF** 350.



- 487 Leopold, 1657-1705. GOLD 5 Ducat, 1703 NB. Nagybanya. 16.54 gm. Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust r., Hungarian shield and Madonna and Child in legend / Crowned Imperial eagle with Arms on breast. *A few apparent prong marks on edge indicate jewelry usage -- typical for this large gold coinage, for nearly all of them were mounted in some fashion for wearing or presentation* **Choice VF** 5,000.
- 488 GOLD 4 Ducat, 1703 NB. Nagybanya. 13.52 gm. Types as above. Broader flange with light, commensurate creases. *Signs of mounting as is usual.* **Good VF** 2,500.



- 489 Karl VI, 1711-1740. GOLD Ducat, 1740 KB. Kremnitz. 3.45 gm. Laureate, draped bust r. / Radiant Madonna and Child over small Arms. Fr 175. **RARE** **Almost EF** 600.



- 490 LUXEMBOURG. Maria Theresa, 1740-1780. Liard, 1759. Crowned oval Arms / Crowned monogram. KM 3 **About EF** 75.
- 491 Leopold II, 1790-1792. Sol, 1790 H. Gunzburg. Crowned Arms / Value and date. KM 15. *Minor flan flaw rev* **Good VF** 90.
- 492 Charlotte, 1919-1964. Medallionic Pattern 100 Francs, 1963. *For the Millennium of Luxembourg City.* 10.15 gm. As regular issue 250 Francs commemorative / Modernistic topographic line map with small Arms; also 250 Francs, 1963. Millennium commemorative. (Set of 2 – only first coin illustrated). **Brilliant UNC** 250.
