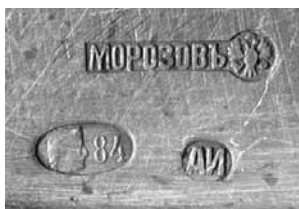

Anchor divides dates 1904 and 1905 / Map of the Eastern hemisphere showing Europe, Africa and Asia with the demarcated journey of the Russian fleet. Чеп 976, V 250. **VERY RARE** original issue. On a bar with ribbon **Choice EF** **1,000.**
- 730 Cap Award ribbon. For Laoyan - August 11-18, Benskicha – September 28-29 of 1904 and February engagements of 1905. Brass. **RARE** multi-campaign ribbon **Problem free** **150.**
- 731 Cap Award ribbon. For Distinction. Copper-nickel. **Scarce** **Problem free** **100.**

- 732 Unique Silver Niello presentation cigarette box in memory of the Russo-Japanese War. Silver. 92 by 62 by 21 mm. 91.2 gm. Hallmarked inside '84' (Sterling) with maker's stamp 'Morozoff, as a warrant of the Imperial Court.' Depicting a naval ship sailing right. Cyrillic inscription on top: "Cruiser 2nd rank 'Novik'". Below: "In memory of service, to Captain 1st Class M.F. Shultz from the officers of the ship. August 12, 1906". Reverse: View of the fortifications at Port Arthur. Legend on top: "Port Arthur." All in niello. *Historically important and unique.* **Some wear due to usage, but absolutely problem-free** **3,000.**

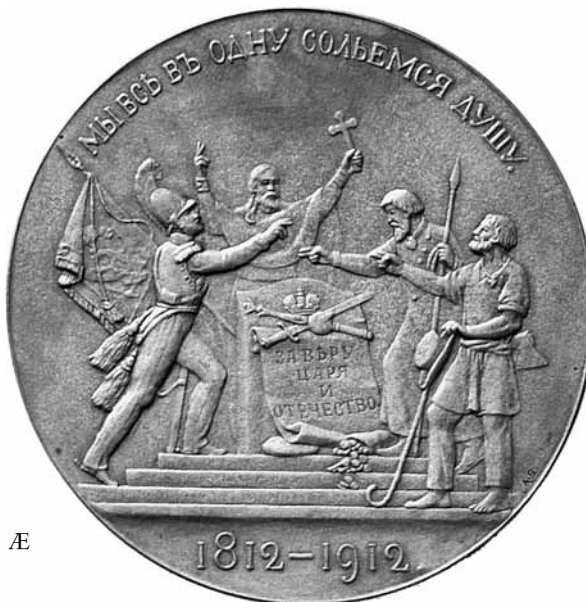
