Maurice Tiberius, 582-602. Æ Pentanummia (= Follis). Cherson mint. Maurice, on l., and the Empress Constantia on r., surrounded by legend / Large H; Theodosius nimbate, stg facing. SB 607; DO 303. Scarce. Very nice green patina. VF to Ch VF. 3 pieces



Alexius I, 1081-1118. AR Aspron Trachy. Pre-reform coinage of 1081-1092. 3.79 gm. Thessalonika. Nimbate Christ enthroned facing, holding Gospels / Nimbate St. Demetrios standing at left, in military attire and holding sword, presents patriarchal cross to Alexius at right, wearing crown and loros. DOC IV pt. 1, 5a. 1; SB 1905. Scarce. Some roughness. Good VF

Georgia. AR 'Kirmanuli'. Georgian imitation of Trebizond Asper of John II. Ca. Late 13th - early 14th Cent. John II, stg. facing, wearing crown, tunic and mantle, holding labarum and globus, with a long cross / St. Eugenius, bearded and nimbate, stg. facing with cross in l. hand. Inscription on both sides is distorted. Cf. Lang 52. Scarce Choice VF
