

THRACE. Odessos. Gordian III, 238-244 AD. AE 37 Medallion. 26.96 gm. Radiate, robed bust l. lifting arm in salute and hldg globe / Sarapis stdg l. hldg cornucopiae and patera over altar. AMNG 2314, cf.SNG-Cop 679 (Obv only). *Sea-olive green. RARE Good VF*

Philippolis. Elagabalus, 218-222 AD. AE 39.5 Medallion. 35.30 gm. Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust l. / Three nude figures standing, the central figure setting down an amphora. BMC--, SNG-Cop--, etc. *Possibly unpublished and EXTREMELY RARE. Glossy blue-green over light pitting and roughness in peripheries Choice VF*



PONTOS. Amaseia. Severus Alexander, 222-235 AD. AE 34, year 234 (232 AD). 24.57 gm. Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust r. / Altar of Zeus Stratios surmounted by eagle standing facing, wings spread, head l., facing quadriga driven by Sol flying above, tree to left of altar. BMC 39/40 var., Mionnet Supp IV p.432,82. *Reddish-brown with green hues. VF*

PAPHLAGONIA. Amastris. Sabina, wife of Hadrian. AE 19. 2.17 gm. Bust r. / Cultus statue of Ephesian Artemis facing, flanked by stylized stags. BMC--; SNG-Cop--. *Rare? Rough Good F*



GALATIA. Galba, 68-69 AD. AE 27. Bare head of Galba r. / Galba cast as the god Men standing l., wearing Phrygian cap, crescent behind shoulders, holding patera and globe. Ashmolean, Oxford, Sear 679. *RARE. Deep blue-green. Some light earthen adhesion and small verdigris on reverse. A handsome portrait. About EF*



CAPPADOCIA. Caesarea. Nero and Divus Claudius. AR Tetradrachm. 13.72 gm. Laur. bust of Nero r., star behind / Laur. bust of Claudius r. Cohen 311,2; SGI 640. Old scratches on both sides. Nice portraits. Scarce About VF to VF

BITHYNIA. Federal Coinage. Hadrian, 117-138 AD. AE 34. Laur. bust r. / Octastyle temple. SNG-Cop 323. *Tooling before bust. Irregular edge. Brown., light earthen green deposits on edge. About VF*



PAPHLAGONIA. Amastris. Sabina, wife of Hadrian. Æ 19. 2.17 gm. Bust r. / Cultus statue of Ephesian Artemis facing, flanked by stylized stags. BMC--; SNG-Cop--. Rare? Rough Good F

CILICIA. Isaura Nova. Caracalla, 198-217 AD. AE 27. Laur., cuir. bust r. / Tetrastyle temple with central arch beneath which is a column surmounted by a bearded bust r. BMC 2. *Olive-brown with orange hues over some roughness.* VF

Tarsos. Caracalla, 198-217 AD. AE 35. Draped, bare bust r., Π-Π / Galley sailing r.. SNG-BN 1526, Cf.SNG-v.Aulock 6018 (obv). *Deep olive-green, near black. Flatly struck upper margin.* About VF

Tarsos. Gordian III, 238-244 AD. AE 36. Radiant, draped bust r., Π behind / Nike standing l. on globe; AMK at left, ΓB at right. SNG-Cop 388. *Brown over scrape top of obv. bust. Even* Fine+. 90.



Antioch. Time of Julius Caesar .AE 23, Pompeian Era Year 19 (48/47 BC ). 8.62 gm. Zeus head r./Zeus enthroned l. with scepter and Victory, figure on ex. RPC 4216. *Tan-brown over minor deposits.* VF



Time of Nero. AE 19, 59/60 AD .Diademed Artemis head r./Lyre. SNG-Cop 108. *Olive green-brown with soft earthen hues.* Choice VF

Antioch. Caracalla, 198-217 AD. Silver Tetradrachm, 211-12 AD. 12.09 gm. Laureate bust r. / Eagle, wings open, stdg on an animal leg, head r., a wreath in its beak. Prieur 214. EF and About as Struck

Antioch. Herennius Etruscus as Caesar, 250-251 AD. Billon Tetradrachm. Bare, draped bust r. / Eagle stdg l. Prieur 630. *Grainy. Toned.* Near EF

ALEXANDRIA. Antonia. Billon Tetradrachm, 41/42 AD. Laureate bust of Claudius r., date LB before / Draped bust of Claudius' mother Antonia r. RPC 5117. *Somewhat grainy, but overall decent metal for issue* VF

Hadrian, 117-138 AD. Billon Tetradrachm, Year 16 (131/2 AD). Laur., draped bust r. / Sarapis enthroned l. hldg scepter, Kerberos before him, date across: LI-S. Milne 1325 var., SNG-Cop 366. *Nice surfaces. Toned.* Good VF



MESOPOTAMIA.Edessa.Gordian III,238-244 AD,and Abgar X.AE 24.Gordian bust r.,star before /Abgar bust r., star behind.BMC 148.Olive-green with orange hues over some roughness. VF
